APRIL 2019 SUPPLY LIST

Divas need to have the following items in preparation for each of the Diva Days Online Crop © activities. Specific Projects have additional supplies so please check for those details as listed below.

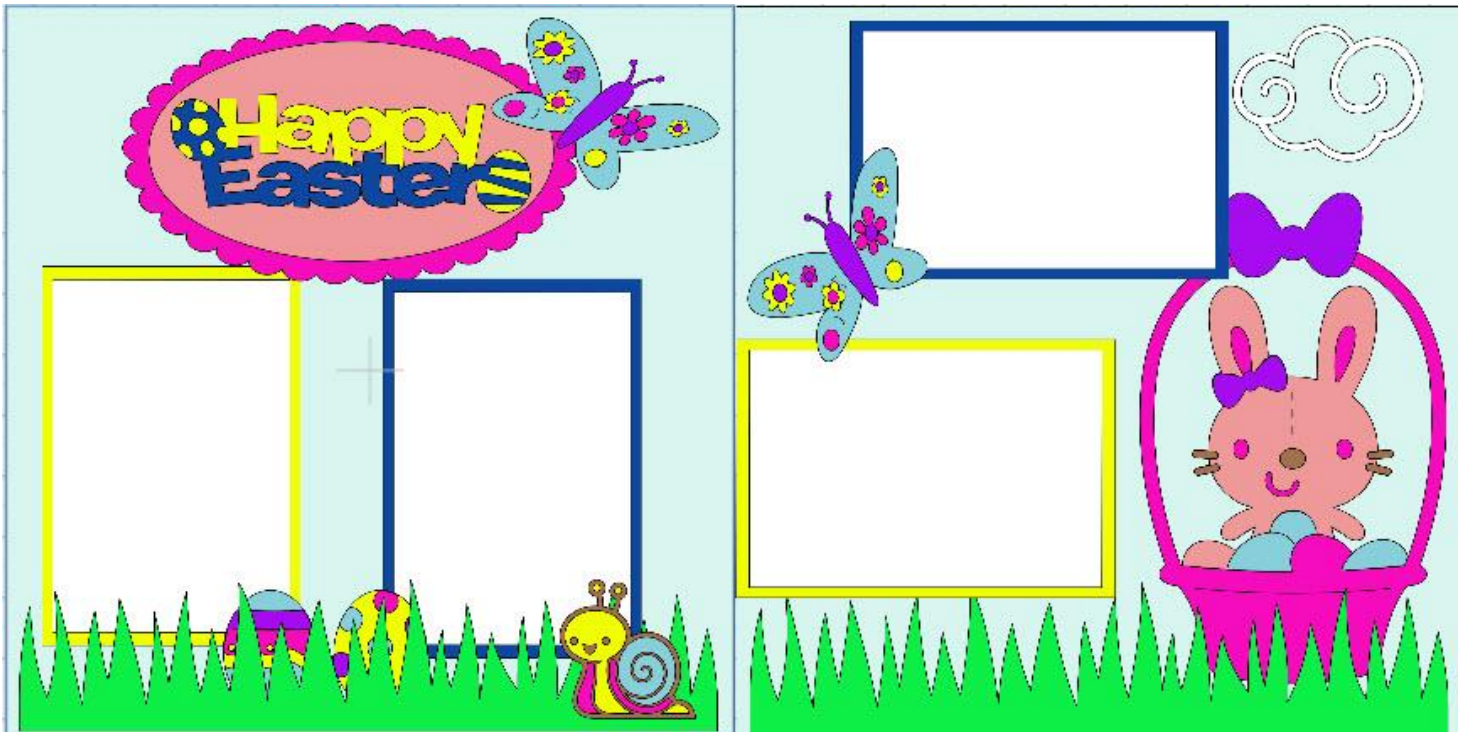
ALL ACTIVITIES:

- Any Cricut Explore / Maker Machine
- Cricut Design Space Account/Cricut Access Subscription OR Purchase individual images as needed
- Computer and Printer * As required for the print then cut projects
- Camera/Phone – take photos to enter Challenges, Contests
- Cricut Mats – 1 OR 2 is good (Light Grip & Standard Grip)
- Cricut Tools - spatula, scrapper, score tool, precision point scissors
- Paper Trimmer
- Assorted Adhesives - tape runner, glue dots, foam dots, double-sided tape, etc.
- Assorted materials such as cardstock, patterned paper, vinyl, iron on, etc. to use for the contests



APRIL 2019 DIVA DAYS PROJECT SUPPLY LIST:

Project #1- EASTER SCRAPBOOK LAYOUT

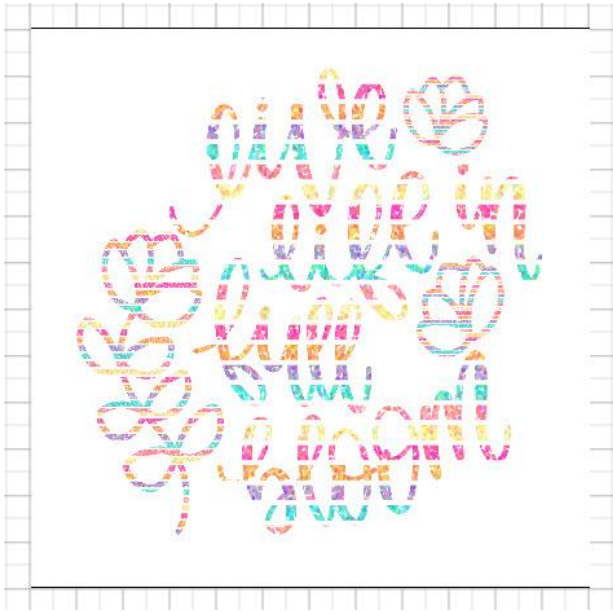


- 12X12 sheets (or use scraps for smaller cuts) of Cardstock Colors: Brown, White, Yellow, Green, Blue, Dark Pink, Purple Optional: Use Small Scale Patterned Paper substitute for Light Pink and Green like I will in my layout
- (2) 12X12 sheets of Light Blue Cardstock to use as the background for layout.
- Adhesives – Tape Runner and Liquid Glue Pen such as Zig Two Way and Foam Pop Dots
- Tools – Use Light Grip Blue Mat, Spatula

HOMEWORK TO DO PRIOR TO DIVA DAYS CLASS

1. Cut out all the shapes in the Design Space Cut File using coordinating Spring Colors of Cardstock and/or patterned paper. DO NOT CUT THE LIGHT BLUE BACKGROUND SHEETS.
2. Set aside the images to assemble in class.

Project #2 – Spring Hot Mess Canvas



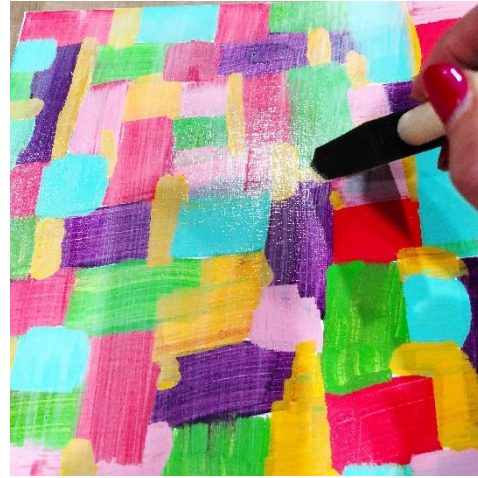
- (1) 12X12 White Canvas Framed
- (1) 12X12 Sheet of Vinyl – removeable type (Cricut or other brand) Color does not matter
- (1) Vinyl Transfer Tape to cover image roughly 10X10
- (1) Acrylic Bottle of Craft Paint in 5 or 6 different “Spring” Colors of your choice PLUS White
- (1) Bottle of Matte Mod Podge (small bottle is fine)
- Paint accessories: 2 palette to pour paint on (I used small paper plate), 6 to 7 1” Disposable sponge paint brushes
- Tools: Use Light Grip Blue Mat for cutting Vinyl, weeding tool, scraper
- 1 Book or Board that fits within the wooden back of the 12X12 canvas to use a hard surface to apply the vinyl in class

HOMEWORK TO DO PRIOR TO DIVA DAYS EVENT

1. Use the Acrylic Paints and foam paint brushes to paint small splotches of the 5 to 6 colors on the 12X12 canvas as shown below. No right or wrong way to do this...just go for it. Let Dry Completely before Step 2.

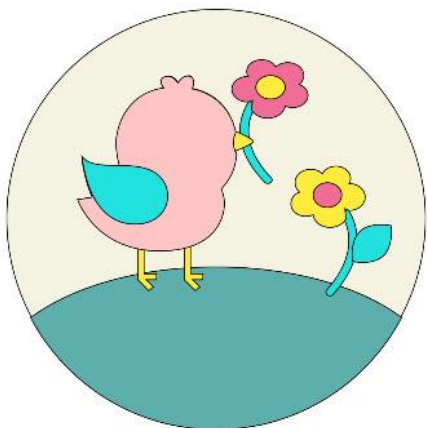


2. Once canvas is painted and completely dry, paint a thin coat of Matte Mod Podge over the painted area. It Dries Clear. Set Aside to Let Dry. We will do the next steps during the Class.



3. Cut out the Phrase in Vinyl. We will weed in class.

Project #3 – Spring Fabric Hoop Art



- (1) 6” Wooden Embroidery Hoop
- Light Colored Fabric (I used Muslin) cut into 8 ½” X 8 ½ “ Square
- (5) Different Patterns of Cotton Fabric in Spring Colors – use smaller prints. I used Cricut Designer Fabric Sets but any 6X6 Fat Quarters would work as well or scraps
- (1) Package of Heat N Bond Ultra
- (1) small button or bead to use as bird eye
- Tools: Pencil, 1 Green Standard Cutting Mat, Scissors, Cricut Easy Press or Household Iron, Easy Press Mat (or other protective ironing surface to use on desk top), Hot Glue Gun/Glue Sticks
- OPTIONAL: Ribbon coordinating color to tie at top of hoop, 1 sheet of 12X12 cardstock to finish backing

HOMEWORK TO DO PRIOR TO DIVA DAYS CLASS

1. Determine which fabric pieces you will use for each shape. Cut the fabric down to approximately that size with a little over lap. Use the Design Space file mats to help you determine how much you will need.
2. Lay the cut fabric pieces on the Heat N Bond Ultra Bond material and cut out with scissors to the size of the fabric. Repeat for each piece.
3. Adhere the Heat N Bond rough side to the wrong side of the fabric piece using either a Cricut Easy Press or a dry household iron following directions on package. Do NOT remove the paper backing from the Heat N Bond, it needs to stay in place after you iron it the rough side on the fabric
4. Place the paper side of the adhered fabric piece on the Green Cricut Cut Mat and cut out the shape using the corresponding Design Space Image in the Cut file.
5. Set aside cut pieces to use in class. Leave the paper backing on.
